



## Sector Scheme 12D T7 Training Course 12D T7 For Managers and Client Officers Training Course

<b>Duration</b>	Two Days
<b>Group Size</b>	Maximum 8 delegates x 1 Instructor Maximum 12 delegates x 2 Instructors
<b>Who Should Attend</b>	12D T7 is targeted at all levels of Management, Client Officers, Technicians and any person not actually installing Temporary Traffic Management (TTM), but requiring a knowledge of basic practice of TTM on urban and rural roads.
<b>Course Aims</b>	To provide delegates with the necessary underpinning knowledge of temporary traffic management and the design procedures used for this within Highway Authorities, Contractors, and for other organisations who require a knowledge of current basic practice with minimum legal requirements where they apply.
<b>Course Objectives</b>	On completion of the session delegates will: - <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Have a working knowledge of National Highway Sector Schemes.</li><li>• Interpret the requirements of 'The Safety at Street Works and Road Works, A Code of Practice (The Red Book)' and further guidance from 'The Traffic Signs Manual, Chapter 8'</li><li>• Consider all options available to determine the level and extent of the Temporary Traffic Management required.</li><li>• Demonstrate knowledge of the site risk assessment process.</li><li>• Have the ability to assess and determine temporary traffic layout required for a given work location, activity or operation.</li><li>• Understand the standard of equipment that is acceptable to use.</li><li>• Realise the implications of changing conditions on site.</li><li>• Have the confidence to liaise with site staff for appropriate remedial actions.</li><li>• Have the ability to confirm suitability of TTM plans prior to work starting on site.</li></ul>
<b>Certification</b>	On completion all delegates will be required to undertake a written examination which carries a 75% pass mark. Lantra Awards (the national awarding body) will issue a certificate to successful candidates with the option of purchasing a card. Refresher training is required every 5 years to keep your certificate or card valid.
