

NRSWA Reassessments - Supervisors

Certificate Aims

This certificate has been designed to allow the candidate to renew their Street Works qualification(s), for those who hold current or recently expired qualifications. This course is best booked within the 6-month leadup to the expiry of your SWQR card, in order to make sure that the card is able to be renewed prior to the expiry date. The new card validity will be equal to 5 years, plus whatever time was remaining on the card prior to expiry. Candidates will have their knowledge brought in line with current legislation to carry out street works to a high standard.

Qualification Structure

The unit is delivered using theory elements to refresh candidates' knowledge and enhance their understanding of the current legislation around street works. Candidates may attend to refresh any or all of the qualifications that are currently on their Street works card of the following units;

- Unit LA Location and Avoidance of Underground Apparatus
- Unit S1 Monitoring Signing, Lighting and Guarding
- Unit S2 Monitoring Excavation in the Highway
- Unit S3 Monitoring Reinstatement of Backfill Materials
- Unit S4 Monitoring Reinstatement of Sub-Base and Base in Non Bituminous Materials
- Unit S5 Monitoring Reinstatement in Bituminous Materials
- Unit S6 Monitoring Reinstatement of Concrete Slabs
- Unit S7 Monitoring Reinstatement of Modular Surfaces and Concrete Footways

The course is assessed using a multiple choice test – one for each unit applied for, with a pass grade of 80%.

Upon successful completion of the course candidates will receive a NRSWA certificate and an updated SWQR card.
